General Performance Index[®]

(**GPI: General Performance Index**): *"It is an index that measures the performance that a tennis player has had in a given period of time."* This index, not shown here, is used to make the "**General Performance Ranking[®]**" or **GPI Ranking[®]** ".

The following tournaments, which correspond to those started in the month of October, have been included for the determination of the **Top 30** of the **General Performance Ranking[®]**:

- **Tianjin Open** – International (hard).
- **Upper Austria Ladies Linz** – International (hard).
- **VTB Kremlin Cup** – International (hard).
- **BGL BNP Paribas Luxembourg Open** – International (hard).
- **WTA Elite Trophy Zhuhai** – Finals (hard).
- **Shiseido WTA Finals Shenzhen** – Finals (hard).

The **WTA Ranking** of the players, which has been considered for this report, is on November 4th, 2019.

Regard the 106 players, whom participated in these six tournaments and who compound the statistic sample that has been considered for the statistical calculations, only the 30 that have achieved the best performance in the mentioned tournaments are exposed (table 1).

We highlight, the podium conformed by **Jelena Ostapenko** (LAT), **Kiki Bertens** (NED) and **Belinda Bencic** (SUI) in positions 1, 2 and 3 of the **GPI Ranking[®]**, respectively.

Other players highlighted in the **TOP 10** of the **GPI Ranking[®]** are: **Dayana Yastremska** (UKR), **Elena Rybakina** (KAZ), **Karolina Muchova** (CZE), **Kristina Mladenovic** (FRA), **Ekaterina Alexandrova** (RUS), **Anastasia Pacliyuchenkova** (RUS) and **Cori Gauff** (USA). See table 1.

It has been only two months since we published, in article No. 92, page 4 that the young Latvian **Jelena Ostapenko** had not stood out in recent times, more precisely since she won **Roland Garrós** in 2017. It seems that the young **Ostapenko** has reacted and this October has made us swallow those comments, being the tennisist with best performer in the month of October.
