## MONTHLY REPORT

### TOP 30 OF THE GENERAL PERFORMANCE RANKING<sup>©</sup> (GPI Ranking<sup>©</sup>)

#### 2019 SEASON, OCTOBER

#### General Performance Index<sup>©</sup>

(GPI: General Performance Index): *"It is an index that measures the performance that a tennis player has had in a given period of time."* This index, not shown here, is used to make the "General Performance Ranking<sup>©</sup> or GPI Ranking<sup>©</sup>".

The following tournaments, which correspond to the month of October, have been included for the determination of the **Top 30** of the **General Performance Ranking<sup>©</sup>**:

- **Rolex Shanghai Masters** – ATP Masters 1000 (hard).
- **European Open** – ATP 250 (hard).
- **VTB Kremlin Cup** – ATP 250 (hard).
- **Intrum Stockholm Open** – (hard).
- **Erste Bank Open** – ATP 250 (hard).
- **Swiss Indoor Basel** – ATP 500 (hard).
- **Rolex Paris Masters** – ATP Masters 1000 (hard).

The **ATP Ranking** of the players, which has been considered for this report, is on November 4<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

The 114 players who have participated in those 7 tournaments and who compound the statistic sample that has been considered for the statistical calculations, we reiterate, only

the 30 with the best performance are exposed in this report.

We highlight the October podium formed by **Denis Shapovalov** (CAN), **Andrey Rublev** (RUS) and **Stefanos Tsitsipas** (GRE), in positions 1, 2 and 3 of the **GPI Ranking<sup>©</sup>**, respectively.

Other prominent players in the **TOP 10** of the **GPI Ranking<sup>©</sup>** are: **Matteo Berrettini** (ITA), **Dominic Thiem** (AUT), **Novak Djokovic** (SRB), **Alex De Minaur** (AUS), **Gael Monfils** (FRA), **Adrian Panatta** (ITA), and **Pablo Carreno Busta** (ESP).

The performance of **Shapovalov**, **Rublev** and **Tsitsipas** has been worthy of mention in this month of October and in the month of November. I mention the month of November, although this month's tournaments are not included in this report, but in the Final of **Davis Cup**, Canada with the leadership of **Denis Shapovalov** reached the final against Spain, where the young Canadian was defeated by **Rafael Nadal** by 3-6, 6 (7) -7. **Denis Shapovalov** had an excellent performance in October and November. On the other hand, the Greek **Stefanos Tsitsipas**, champion of the **Nitto ATP Finals** joins to demonstrate,

once again, that he will be a permanent member of that elite of world tennis in the coming years. I have been lucky to see him play two matches in London at the **Nitto ATP Finals**, the semifinal against **Roger Federer** and the final against **Dominic Thiem**, and his game is really very good and he is a candidate to dispute No. 1 in the **ATP Ranking** in the not so far future. Anyway, since 2004 that No. 1 of the **ATP Ranking** has been in the hands of only four players, **Federer**, **Nadal**, **Djokovic** and **Murray**, that's why it's time for other players to have the opportunity to enjoy that privilege, otherwise, if **Nadal** or **Djokovic** (**Murray** is returning) become as long-standing (with regard tennis) and successful as **Roger Federer**, this young generation will have to wait at least 4 or 5 more years to reach No. 1 in the **ATP Ranking**. The shadow of **Big 3** is still strong. The young players are hungry ... and want more.

Personally I wish to see a young player in the No. 1 of the **ATP Ranking**, but in order to achieve this, they have to beat the **Big 3**, today the opponent to beat is **Rafael Nadal**, who increasingly plays better and has adapted his tennis to the demands of the new trends.

Next, the tables with their respective performance rankings or **GPI Ranking**<sup>®</sup> are exposed as is usual, in each analyzed aspect of the 30 players that achieved the highest performances during the analysis period.

Remember, each table presented here has its own **GPI Ranking**<sup>®</sup>, and the combination of all tables results in Table 1, which is the result of all the tables presented in this report.
