General Performance Index[©]

(GPI: General Performance Index): "It is an index that measures the performance that a tennis player has had in a given period of time." This index, not shown here, is used to build the "General Performance Index Ranking® or GPI Ranking®".

This index considers, for its calculation, a number of aspects such as the number of played matches and won, the serves, the points won with the serves, the returns, the break points (saved and won) and the tiebreaks. Once the indexes are calculated for a given period of time, the 2023 season in this case, these indexes are sorted from the

highest to the lowest and a ranking is established. This ranking is the General Performance Index Ranking® or GPI Ranking®, which is used to order players by performance in the analyzed season. As already mentioned in other articles, the WTA Ranking must not necessarily coincide with the General Performance Index Ranking®, in fact, this rarely happens (Iga Swiatek, Marketa Vondrousova). This General Performance Index Ranking® is very useful because it allows analyzing and quantifying the performance of an athlete in relation to the other players over a period of time.

The best performance of the season in the WTA 1000 tournaments has been achieved by the Polish Iga Swiatek (POL), number 1 in the world ranking, followed by the Kazakhstani Elena Rybakina (KAZ), completing the podium of the GPI Ranking[®] the Belarusian Aryna Sabalenka (BLR).

Other players highlighted in the GPI Ranking® have been Coco Gauff (USA), Karolina Muchova (CZE), Jessica Pegula (USA), Marketa Vondrousova (CZE), Maria Sakkari (GRE), Liudmila Samsonova (RUS) and Jelena Ostapenko (LAT) whom complete the Top 10 of the GPI Ranking® for WTA 1000 tournaments.
