ATP TOP 100 - STATISTICS OF 2015 SEASON

Date of Report¹: 29.08.2015

This report sets out relevant performance statistics of the ATP **TOP 100** (Ranking updated: 24.08.2015).

The analysis covers the period from 01.01.2015 to 23.08.2015. For ATP are included the ATP World Tour 250, 500, 1000. For the ITF are included Australian Open, Roland Garros, Wimbledon, and the Davis Cup. There are not statistics contemplated for all tournaments classifications including the Grand Slams, Challengers and the others ATP tournaments.

The tables are presented for each player and the analysts can draw their own conclusions. For example, to analyze the performance of a particular player must take into account all categories of statistics. With this procedure will give a good approximation of the real performance of the player so far in the 2015 season. *The statistics about speed serve, winners, unforced errors, forced errors and net points won are partial so this is the reason that are not published in this report and those that have been exposed in previous reports must take account of this review, are partial and are for reference only.*

Service and Return

It is difficult to say who better served in the 2015 season because some players are really good in some ways and others in other issues. I have selected a group that has had an excellent performance service and return this season.

In terms of number of "Aces" **Ivo Karlovic** (Table 1 and 6) is the undisputed leader of the season with 1,112 aces, followed closely by **John Isner** with 1,015 aces. If we had used only this criterion to determine the best server would be **Karlovic** the best, but we must consider other aspects such as the

"aim" or services within the service zone. In this way, with regard to **Isner**'s first service this is the best of all because he obtained the 84% of the first serves and won the 80% of them. This tells us that **Isner** has won between 6 and 7 balls with his first service (80% of 84%) in the season. These numbers are amazing!!!. On the other hand, **Karlovic** got 66% of his first services and won the 85% of them which would give us that Ivo earns between 5 and 6 balls with the first service. Certainly, in this category, **Isner has the best first service in the world.**

Regarding the second service the great merit is to win it because all the players have good aim with the second serve but it is more slowly. In this case, we note that the players who have the best performance with the second service are almost the same that have the best performance with the first service, except a new member, nothing less than the number one of the world ranking, **Novak Djokovic**, who holds the first place in the planet in the percentage won with his second serve (Table 11). Another participant of weight is the living legend **Roger Federer** who occupies the 4th and 3rd place with regard the points won with the first and second services respectively.

In my opinion the best servers of the 2015 season so far are **Isner, Karlovic, Raonic, Federer and Djokovic** in that order, I have no doubt. After these five there is a legion of good servers.

Regarding the service return there are others players in the season as the best returners like **David Ferrer, Novak Djokovic, Andy Murray, Benoit Paire, Rafael Nadal, David Goffin, Tomas Berdych** and **Kei Nishikori**, in that order. **David Ferrer stand out as the best returner of the first services and Novak Djokovic as the best returner of the second services** in the 2015 season (See Table 13 and 14).

Regarding the Break Points Won, **Andy Murray, Novak Djokovic and Rafael Nadal are the best breakers of the second service** of their rivals which is consistent with the performance of their second returns services, especially in the case of **Djokovic** and **Murray** (**Rafael Nadal** stand out in the 7th place of the return points won with the second service).

It would be unfair mention only the best servers, we should mention the worst returners of the season too. Indeed, those players who hold the better first service in the world of tennis and whose game structure depends mainly on their first service (**Karlovic, Isner, Raonic, Anderson**) are precisely those who that are occupying the worst posts in the TOP 100 regarding the first and second returns (see Tables 13 and 14). In the first return points won **the best servers are in the last posts of the TOP 100: Anderson: 74, Raonic: 92 Karlovic 95 and Isner 100.**

The spectacular first services of **Isner, Karlovic, Raonic** and **Anderson** are neutralized by the poor performance in their returns points won, especially with the first service of the rivals. I do not want to imagine if **Karlovic, Isner** or **Raonic** had the returns of **Djokovic** or **Murray**, they would be practically invincible.

In Table 1 where it says "1st Service In" John Isner did not obtain 84% of the serves, he really gained only the 71%. I apologize for this error but I emphasize this because he is one of the best servers of the moment. The amount of data to be loaded into the database is enormous throughout the season and, in this case, it was the only registered error "so far".
