Next, the tables of the **Top 50** are shown in each aspect analyzed.

Finally, we have the first quarterly report of the performances of the **WTA** players. The podium, in this case, is made up by **Bianca Andreescu** (CAN), **Karolina Pliskova** (CZE) and **Petra Kvitova** (CZE), in positions 1, 2 and 3, respectively of the **General Performance Ranking[©]** or **GPI Ranking[©]**.

The rest of the players are shown in table 1, standing out **Simona Halep** (ROU), **Belinda**

Bencic (SUI), **Ashleigh Barty** (AUS), **Su-Wei Hsieh** (TPE), **Yafan Wang** (CHN), **Anett Kontaveit** (EST) and **Kiki Bertens** (NED), among others.

There are 5 **Top 10** of the **WTA Ranking** included in the **Top 10** of the **GPI Ranking[©]**. However, the best performance player this first quarterly of the 2019 season, has been the Canadian **Bianca Andreescu** with WTA Ranking 23, who in the end has the greater number of matches played, 29 in total.

The **WTA Ranking** that has been taken for this report is on April 4th, 2019.

Next, the tables of the **Top 50** of the **GPI Ranking[©]** are shown in each aspect analyzed.

This table 6, must be analyzed together with tables 4 and 5, of points won with the 1st and 2nd services. We note that the podium of table 1: **Bianca Andreescu**, **Petra Kvitova** and **Karolina Pliskova** has remained at the top of the tables in this report. I recommend seeing the articles 75, 77 and 79 of January, February and March respectively, to analyze the regularity of the players.

One aspect to highlight is the case of **Simona Halep**, who in tables 4 and 5 has obtained the position 7, but in the table 6 reached only the position 19, despite having had a good performance in the points won

with their services, both of the 1st as of the 2nd .

This could be explained in the following way, **Halep** is not playing well the important points on average, relatively speaking and always comparing it with the Top players. The impression, at the first glance, is that when she is in the situation of save the break points, she does not achieve to obtain the same performance as when she wins the points with her services, on average. It can be a matter of confidence in this aspect, because in the other areas she shows that she is one of the best players in the circuit. A pending issue for her and her team to analyze it in detail.

This table 7, is analyzed with tables 8 and 9 of points won with the returns of the rivals' services. Once again, we observe that, the podium of table 1 is the same. To be fair in the analysis and again getting **Simona Halep** as an example, we note that in this table 7 she has reached the 4th place of the **GPI Ranking**[®] of break points won. Halep is

4th and 5th in the returns of the 1st and 2nd services. The statistical reading is that **Halep** is an excellent returner and has a lot of confidence with that hit (return). I have taken **Simona Halep** as an example, but the rest of the players can be analyzed with this criterion.

In the **Top 100** of the **WTA Ranking**, with the exception of **Natalia Vikhlyantseva** (112), is including the **Top 50** of the **GPI Ranking**[®]. It is very difficult for some player, for example, with a **WTA Ranking** of 200, 300 or more, to be among the **Top 50** of the best performance. An exception could occur, in which case we will mention it opportunely or we would have mentioned it, but in general, those who achieve a good performance in this type of competition, are the players with the best ranking.

These are the statistics for the first quarterly of the 2019 season.
