TOP 30 OF THE GENERAL PERFORMANCE RANKING[®] (GPI Ranking[®])

2019 SEASON, AUGUST

General Performance Index[®]

(**GPI: General Performance Index**): *"It is an index that measures the performance that a tennis player has had in a given period of time."* This index, not shown here, is used to make the "**General Performance Ranking[®]**" or **GPI Ranking[®]**".

The following tournaments, which correspond to those started in the month of August, have been included for the determination of the **Top 30** of the **General Performance Ranking[®]**:

- **Rogers Cup** – Premier 5 (hard).
- **Western & Southern Open** – Premier 5 (hard).
- **Bronx Open** – International (hard).
- **US Open** – Grand Slam (hard).

The **WTA Ranking** of the players, which has been considered for this report, is on September 9th, 2019.

Regard the 129 players, whom participated in these four tournaments and who compound the statistic sample that has been considered for the statistical calculations,

only the 30 that have achieved the best performance in the mentioned tournaments are exposed (table 1).

We highlight, the podium conformed by **Bianca Andreescu** (CAN), **Sofia Kenin** (USA) and **Serena Williams** (USA) in positions 1, 2 and 3 of the **GPI Ranking[®]**, respectively.

Other players highlighted in the **TOP 10** of the **GPI Ranking[®]** are: **Madison Keys** (USA), **Naomi Osaka** (JPN), **Svetlana Kuznetsova** (RUS), **Karolina Pliskova** (CZE), **Elina Svitolina** (UKR), **Donna Vekic** (CRO) and **Ashleigh Barty** (AUS). See table 1.

We can see, in table 1, that the absent ones in the **Top 30** of the **GPI Ranking[®]** of August and that they belong to the **Top 10** of the **WTA Ranking** have been, **Petra Kvitova** (7) and **Kiki Bertens** (8).

In table 2, we can see that 20 **Top 30** of the **WTA Ranking** are included in the **Top 30** of the **GPI Ranking[®]**.

The star of the month is, obviously, **Bianca Andreescu** who recently won the **US Open**

by defeating the powerful **Serena Williams** 6-3, 7-5. An indisputable victory where **Andreescu** categorically defeated the always dangerous **Serena Williams** giving a little fresh air to the female circuit and highlighting that, little by little, the new generations are making their way inexorably, although that veterans are still fighting and others want to return in 2020 (Kim Clijsters) to show that they can compete with ages close to 40 years old. Unfortunately, **Serena Williams**, couldn't get her Grand Slam 24, and as the months go away, that possibility is vanishing. Similar to the case of **Roger Federer**.

Regarding the young Canadian, **Bianca Andreescu**, during the month of August she made a great campaign, won 13/13 matches played (table 3). **Bianca** only played two tournaments in August, the **Roger Cup** (WTA Premier 5) where she was champion defeating in the final to **Serena Williams** by retirement and then, as already mentioned in previous paragraphs, **Bianca** defeated **Serena Williams** again at the **US Open**. Without a doubt, a new star has been born in the world tennis firmament, and that star is called **Bianca Andreescu**. We hope that she will achieve acceptable regularity in the future and she does not lost in the galaxy, such

as the example of **Jelena Ostapenko** (LAT), who after winning **Roland Garros** in 2017, practically evaporated from the instances of the main tournaments of the **WTA**, a fleeting star?, well, there is time to prove the opposite, **Jelena Ostapenko** is still very young.

Finally, although the exposed tables do not need an additional explanation, because they expose the performance in different aspects, I would like to mention the young American **Sofia Kenin** (USA), who has also had an outstanding role during the month of August. **Madison Keys** (USA), is another player who deserves to be mentioned for her performance. For a matter of time, the other players are not mentioned but, if they appear in table 1, it is because they have been the best 30 of the month of August, regarding their performance, without a doubt.

Next, the tables with their respective performance rankings or **GPI Ranking**[®] are exposed as is usual, in each analyzed aspect of the 30 players that achieved the highest performances during the analysis period³.
