## MONTHLY REPORT

### TOP 30 OF THE GENERAL PERFORMANCE RANKING<sup>©</sup> (GPI Ranking<sup>©</sup>)

#### 2019 SEASON, AUGUST

##### General Performance Index<sup>©</sup>

**(GPI: General Performance Index):** "It is an index that measures the performance that a tennis player has had in a given period of time." This index, not shown here, is used to make the "General Performance Ranking<sup>©</sup>" or **GPI Ranking<sup>©</sup>**".

The following tournaments, which correspond to the month of August, have been included for the determination of the **Top 30** of the **General Performance Ranking<sup>©</sup>**:

- **Coupe Rogers** – ATP Masters 1000 (hard).
- **Western & Southern Open** – ATP Masters 1000 (hard).
- **Winston-Salem** – ATP 250 (hard).
- **US Open** – Grand Slam (hard).

The **ATP Ranking** of the players, which has been considered for this report, is on September 9<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

The 137 players who have participated in those 4 tournaments and who compound the statistic sample that has been considered for the statistical calculations, we reiterate, only the 30 with the best performance are exposed in this report.

According to table 1, seven (7) **Top 10** of the **ATP Ranking** appear in the **Top 30** of the **GPI Ranking<sup>©</sup>**. These are, **Novak Djokovic** (1), **Rafael Nadal** (2), **Roger Federer** (3), **Daniil Medvedev** (4), **Alexander Zverev** (6), **Karen Khachanov** (9) and **Roberto Bautista Agut** (10). The absent in the **Top 30** of the **GPI Ranking<sup>©</sup>** are the **Top 10**: **Dominic Thiem** (5), **Stefanos Tsitsipas** (7) and **Kei Nishikori** (8)

We highlight the August podium formed by **Daniil Medvedev** (RUS), **Andrey Rublev** (RUS) and **Rafael Nadal** (ESP), in positions 1, 2 and 3 of the **GPI Ranking<sup>©</sup>**, respectively.

Other prominent players in the **TOP 10** of the **GPI Ranking<sup>©</sup>** are: **Denis Shapovalov** (CAN), **Diego Schwartzman** (ARG), **Hubert Hurkacz** (POL), **Gael Monfils** (FRA), **David Goffin** (BEL), **Benoit Paire** (FRA) and **Richard Gasquet** (FRA).

The outstanding player of August was the young Russian **Daniil Medvedev**, who during the month of August achieved three finals, obtaining 1 title and two runners-up, namely: runner-up in the **Coupe Rogers** losing to **Rafael Nadal** 3-6, 0-6, champion at the **Western &**

**Southern Open** (ATP Masters 1000) beating Belgian **David Goffin** in the final by 7-6 (3), 6-4 and at the **US Open** was runner-up falling defeated by living legend **Rafael Nadal** in five sets, 5-7, 3-6, 7-5, 6-4 and 4-6 in 4 hours and 49 minutes, one of the most extensive finals in the history of the **US Open**.

Regardless of some picturesque situation at the **US Open**, **Daniil Medvedev** presents himself as a tennis player with a promising future in the professional circuit. His performance in the month of August is the equivalent of a titan, demonstrating that he has a mind capable of overcoming the fatigue and boos of the public, feeding himself, according to his comments, from the negative energy of the public and transforming it into a positive energy food. He belongs to the new generation of players (NextGen) and I hopefully he achieves the necessary regularity to remain in the **Top 10** for many years.

On the other hand, about **Rafael Nadal** nothing to add more than everyone already knows

about him. I have always maintained, since I started more than a decade ago with this website that, **Federer**, **Djokovic** and **Nadal**, have some combination in their DNA that the rest of the players do not have it and makes them different, although someone does not like this comment or comparison, but the facts are there. The three have won 55 Grand Slams (**Roger** 20, **Rafa** 19 and **Novak** 16), the most demanding tournaments, not counting the large number of ATP Masters 1000. This closes the mouth to anyone. All three are fantastic, the best of tennis in the last 100 years.

Next, the tables with their respective performance rankings or **GPI Ranking<sup>©</sup>** are exposed as is usual, in each analyzed aspect of the 30 players that achieved the highest performances during the analysis period.

Remember, each table presented here has its own **GPI Ranking<sup>©</sup>**, which they are combined together and gives as output the Table 1.
